

## Ryder Project Space – Studio available from 21 May 2018 to 30 June 2019

A.P.T is pleased to announce the provision of a project studio for visual artists is continuing for a second year.





**The Ryder Project Space will be offered to a visual artist to enable a specific project, artwork or activity to be researched, produced or delivered. We are interested in receiving proposals that make good use of the studio space and our aim is to encourage the delivery of a project that might not otherwise reach fruition.**

Please submit a detailed project proposal along with the completed application form.

The selected artist will join A.P.T from 14 May 2018 to 30 June 2019, they will become a member of the charity and will benefit from our strong community of 42 visual artists and our local networks. The studio space recognises the contribution that David Ryder has made to A.P.T; he was integral in setting up A.P.T in 1995 and was a Trustee for 21 years. David is now an honorary member of A.P.T and will be sitting on the selection panel.

The Ryder Project Space Studio is on the first floor of A.P.T and is 182 sq ft. It has no natural daylight but does have a window that opens on to the corridor. The monthly rent is £116.03 (to be reviewed in May 2018). Electricity is metered and usage is charged annually. A three month deposit will be required and there is a £100 administration charge to join A.P.T.
